
Using Flock Multi Geo Search

Identifying "Vehicles of Interest" in potential drug trafficking from Detroit pipeline through Knoxville using Flock advanced search


- Collectively our unit has maybe 20 -25 cases just from Flock this year. You could say the same for last year too.
- Got another one Tuesday night (Oct 1st) a rental car driving down Broadway, checked the Flock history it had a lot of scans Detroit and Knoxville.
- Got PC tried to stop him and he ran.
- Chased him while he was throwing dope out the window.
- Took him into custody went back and recovered over 2 ounces of meth and an ounce of fentanyl.
- He was on the phone in the pursuit, we found his apartment got a search warrant but by the time we hit it 3 hours later they had cleared it out but we found a lot of baggies and processing equipment.


Use of Multi-Geo for "Vehicles of Interest" Drug Interdiction



METRO DETROIT start of the pipeline - Detroit camera group




End of Pipeline - using Knoxville camera group






What Vehicles have been in Detroit and Knoxville between 9/24 and 9/30




1st Candidate - In Detroit and Knoxville - Kentucky tag C3 - 9/25 - multiple times




9/29 - multiple locations drug areas Knoxville






- What do you notice about this car?
- No dealership sticker or license plate bracket
- No tint on glass
- No bumper stickers
- Nothing to indicate a privately owned vehicle.

Searched 67,329 Cameras nationwide - Two distinctive locations are found Detroit - Knoxville





Summary

- Two search groups created based on the nexus between two drug trafficking locations (Detroit and Knoxville).
- Used a manageable date range for analysis.
- A *vehicle of interest* quickly found in both Detroit and Knoxville in multiple locations known for drug activity during short time interval.
- A nationwide search of over 67,000 cameras reveals no other distinctive locations.
- Vehicle appears to be a rental (no dealership stickers, no tinted glass).
- Further research begins on rental company driver and other factors before any action is taken.
- This starts the investigation other corroborating information will be used before this vehicle becomes a trafficking suspect.


Convoy Search

Identify vehicles that have been seen together so you can verify a potential accomplice and getaway car used during a string of vehicle thefts; Show me vehicles that were seen near this specific car multiple times.

- April 2023 Jeffersontown, KY
 Robbery of an ATM technician working on a PNC ATM. Suspects took over \$85,000 during the Robbery.
- PNC Bank video surveillance captured the suspect vehicle (white Jeep) with temporary Indiana license plate.



Jeffersontown Police Detective Jennifer Caudill found suspect vehicle using Convoy search in the same area as the victim's service truck multiple times.



Harrison County Indiana

After robbery vehicle fled to Indiana


1st read getting off the expressway with TEMP Tag

2nd read approximately 23 minutes later displaying a *Texas registration*.





Detective Caudill located the suspect vehicle with the Texas tag in Louisville Ky two days prior to the Robbery in Jeffersontown.
